Demonstrate and verbalize examination of sterilant (cup) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> make sure it is not outdated make sure not hard (gently squeeze to break up contents) make sure nails do not pierce the cup make sure color of cup is not yellow 		
Demonstrate biological testing <ul style="list-style-type: none"> don gloves and obtain biological kit from the refrigerator Open biological indicator and grasp with orange clip and place in tray add the chemical strip to the same tray place sterilant cup into machine, push gently until pierces bottom ; insert aspirator into the middle of the top of sterilant making sure there are no kinks in tubing Run the cycle check if cup is empty after cycle and the parameters were met (computer print out) check monitoring strip if turns light blue place run biological indicator (from Steris) into medium being careful not to contaminate; goes into incubator with documentation of date, Steris # and initials place a fresh biological into medium (control); document date, initial and check control box

State action taken when parameters/biological/strips are abnormal <ul style="list-style-type: none"> rerun test notify Charge Nurse if still abnormal & place machine out of order
